

Eligibility: A minimum of three simple (S) passes or above in a combination of approved subjects (single sitting) and a minimum score of 30% for the Common General Paper at the G.C.E A/L Examination conducted by the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka, or any other qualification of comparable standing such as Edexcel / Cambridge Examinations recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of Sri Lanka.


Centre for Entrepreneurship Development
